The international panel chosen for the evaluation of the IDPASC-Portugal Doctoral Program fellowships met in the Laboratório de Instrumentação e Física Experimental de Partículas (LIP) in Lisbon on the 02/11/2017 at 2:30 pm. The first session ended at 8:00 pm and the panel met again on the 03/11/2017 at 9:00 am to close the evaluation procedure at 1:00 pm. The panel members Francisco del Águila, José Valle, Marcella Diemoz, Andreas Glindemann and Jorge Crispim Romão (President) were present in both sessions. Kostas Kokkotas and Enrique Zas, were not present in Lisbon but connected via Skype during the meeting. João Alves could not be present in the meeting nor connected via Skype during the sessions but he already filled in the reports assigned to him.

The panel reviewed all the 16 applications presented to this call. The procedure followed what was announced in the terms of the call. Each application was evaluated according to the following three criteria, in a scale from 1 (minimum) to 5 (maximum):

- Merit of the candidate (weight 5)
- Work Plan (weight 3)
- Merit of the Supervisor/Institution (weight 2)

Each candidate was evaluated by two different members of the panel and interviewed by one of them, and during the meeting the whole panel discussed each application until a grade was agreed by consensus. The summary of the interviews was presented to the panel during the discussion and taken into account in the final grading of the Merit of the Candidate.

The quality of the applications to this call was excellent with 8 applications scoring 3.8 or above. The panel recommends that the applications with a final grade above or equal to 3.8 can be considered to be awarded in case of availability. The prioritized requirement of one fellowship to the University of Coimbra was not met by any of these 8 applications. Two of the ordered 8 candidates satisfy the prioritized requirement of awarding one fellowship in case of co-supervision between two different institutions.
